

This week in Reception we have been looking at the story, 'Tadpole's Promise'. The children have been learning about the life cycle of a frog and that frogs start off as frogspawn. The children have been sequencing the story and writing speech bubbles. In Maths the children have been recapping their knowledge on 3D shapes. We experimented with the shapes and sorted them into what shapes can roll and what shapes can slide. We also went out into the allotments and planted seeds in our flower beds. We planted spinach, carrots, potatoes, beetroots and spring onions. The children have also planted their own peas and they are now growing. The children check on them each day to see which one is now the tallest.
