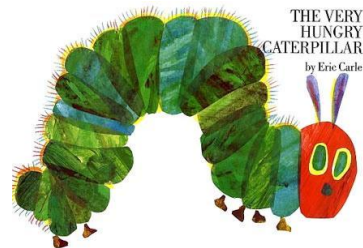


**Next week we will be baking on a Monday. This week we didn't get chance to, but we will be making pizzas.**

This week we have been looking at the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar'. The children listened to the story and they acted it out. They also sequenced it and wrote some sentences. The children then made up their own endings to the story. We had tigers, snakes and even baby chicks coming out of the cocoon. In Maths we have been looking at bigger and smaller numbers and ordering numbers. The children had lots of fun using the ordering games on the Interactive Whiteboard. In RE we have been learning about Palm Sunday. In Understanding the World we have been looking at experiments with food colouring, milk and water. The children have had a turn at changing the colour of water and watching what happens when colours were added to milk. It was very messy!
